

1. Any funding application must comply with at least one of the following areas, as outlined in the Guidelines and Areas of Interest document -
 - a. Sport and Recreation
 - b. Business Enterprise
 - c. Education and Training
 - d. Community Needs
2. Funding is subject to the available resources of the Charity and therefore all applications may not be funded.
3. Applicants may not receive the full amount requested, the decision of the Charity Trustees is final in all matters pertaining to grant aid.
4. Only requests received on the official Application Form will be considered; no other requests via email, letter, verbal, or another medium will be allowable.
5. Trustees may request additional information from applicants, either in writing or by interview.
6. Canvassing is not allowed and will result in a refusal to consider an application.
7. All information on the Application Form must be accurate; any fraudulent information will lead to the rejection of the application.
8. If an application is successful, the applicant will receive a Letter of Offer which must be signed and returned within **2 weeks** to accept the grant and indicate agreement to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
9. All applications will be assessed against set criteria based on the aims and objectives of the charity.
10. The Brighter Futures charitable fund will ensure the promotion of equality of opportunity between -
